# TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

#### **FORMAT**

There are four separate competitions:

- 1. Low Professional
- 2. Professional on Low Net Team
- 3. 18-hole Best Ball of Foursome, Low Gross
- 4. 18-hole Best Ball of Foursome, Low Net (80% of Course Handicap for Amateur Players)

The Professional is responsible for maintaining the scorecard of the team. At the completion of the round, the scorecard shall be signed by the professional and attested by one of the team members. Penalties for violations shall be consistent with other scoring rules (see Rule 6-6).

#### **GENERAL**

- Pairings and Tournament Information have been sent to each team
  Golf Professional. The morning tee times will begin at <u>7:30 a.m.</u> and the afternoon tee times will begin at <u>12:30 p.m.</u>
- Championship Flagsticks are embedded with reflectors compatible with %aser Link+measuring devices.
- Sleepy Hollow Country Club has been measured for GPS (see Local Rules).
- The Locker Room will open at 6:30 a.m. Players are <u>encouraged</u> to change their golf shoes in the Locker Room. Please do not change your golf shoes in the parking lot.
- The Pro Shop will open at 6:30 a.m.
- The Practice Range will open at 6:30 a.m. Range Balls will be provided courtesy of the MGA.

#### **DRESS**

No %hort shorts+, jeans, cargo pants, cargo shorts, cut-offs, mock shirts or t-shirts. Players and caddies must wear collared shirts.

#### **GOLF SHOES**

Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are **prohibited**. Penalty for breach of this condition: **Disqualification**.

#### **CADDIES**

Each group will be assigned two golf carts and one club caddie. Club caddie fees will be paid courtesy of the MGA. Each player is required to pay a gratuity of \$25.00 to their club caddie.

# I-87 North (Major Deegan Expressway-NY Thruway):

- To Exit 9 (last exit before Bridge-Route 9/Tarrytown).
- Turn left off ramp onto Route 119 West.
- Proceed 0.3 miles to Route 9, turn right (north).
- \* Proceed 4.3 miles (passing through Tarrytown), entrance on right (between stone gates) immediately after Sleepy Hollow Road.

#### Tappan Zee Bridge:

- IMMEDIATELY after toll take 1st exit on right Route 9-Tarrytown.
- Turn right onto Route 9 (north).
- \* Proceed as above.

#### I-287 (Cross Westchester Expressway Westbound):

- To Exit 3 (Sprain Brook Parkway) North.
- Proceed north on Sprain Brook Parkway, when it joins Taconic Parkway continue north.
- Take 1st Exit after crossing over Saw Mill Parkway (Route 117).
- At end of exit ramp turn left onto Route 117.
- Proceed west approximately 5.0 miles to Route 9.
- Turn right (north) onto Route 9, proceed approximately 1.0 mile to Club entrance on right.
