

EVENT INFORMATION

- Parking:** Bethpage Bike Parking – Across the street from the Polo Field Farmingdale, N.Y.
Please see the attached map for additional information.
- Date:** Saturday, October 5, 2024
- Registration:** Players should arrive on property 30 minutes before their starting time to check-in at registration and receive their tee gifts.
- Format:**
- Players will hit 10 drives each over the course of 5 minutes.
 - There will be a running clock and when time is up, your turn is up. The clock starts once the player makes their first swing.
 - The longest drive of the 10 that comes to rest within the 'grid' will count for the division and overall competitions.
 - Drives will be measured with GolfZone Wave and physically measured on the Grid, the physical measurement will be the official distance.
 - The top 2 overall male and female players will compete in a sudden-death playoff at the conclusion of the competition. Additional information is below.
- Equipment:**
- Players are required to bring their own driver, golf shoes and glove.
 - Players will be provided tees of various sizes and Callaway Golf Balls for the competition. All players must use the provided golf balls for the Championship.
 - Players will tee off from a matt and will be standing on grass, golf shoes are encouraged.
- Playoff:** At the conclusion of play, there will be a sudden-death playoff for the top two players in the male and female overall competition. There will NOT be a play off for the individual divisions. If you are not in the top 2 when you finish, you do not need to stay on property.
- Playoff Format:** The top 2 male players will tee off consecutively followed by the top 2 female players. Each player will hit 10 shots and the longest drive within the 'grid' will be crowned the Long Drive Champion.
- Food & Beverage:** Water and soft drinks will be provided to all players on site and snacks will be available throughout the day.
- The Grid:** The Grid will be the roped in area setup on the polo field, it is 60 yards wide and runs the entire length of the field. In order for a drive to count towards the competition the ball must come to rest within the Grid.
