

- All final field competitors for the 2024 Long Island Mid-Amateur Championship have been accorded the courtesy of a practice round at The Bridge.
- Players <u>must text</u> Chandler Dunning, Caddie Manager, at (912) 996 0777 to make arrangements on a first come first served basis.
- Players are limited to one practice round only.
- Practice Rounds are walking only. Players may carry their own bag or take a club caddie.
- No guests are permitted. Players may not bring their own caddie for their practice round.
- Players are only permitted to use practice facilities at The Bridge on the day of their scheduled practice round and no more than one hour before their scheduled practice round.
- During the practice round, players should play from appropriate tee markers. Please be aware of your pace of play and member play.
- Practice Rounds are available on the following dates based on availability:
  - Monday, September 30<sup>th</sup>
  - Wednesday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - Thursday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>

## DRESS

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players must wear collared shirts. Wearing jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited. The Committee in charge decides whether this requirement has been met and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.
