



## PRACTICE ROUND NOTICE

### 122nd Met Amateur Championship

Somerset Hills Country Club, Bernardsville, NJ • Thursday - Sunday, August 1 - 4

All final field competitors for the 122<sup>nd</sup> Met Amateur Championship have been accorded the courtesy of a practice round at Somerset Hills Country Club.

- Players must contact Michael Stone at [mstone@somersetcc.org](mailto:mstone@somersetcc.org) to schedule their practice round.
- Players are limited to **one** practice round **only**.
- All players must walk for the practice round and players have the option to reserve a club caddie. The caddie fee for the Met Amateur practice round is \$120.00 per player (tip not included).
- Players **may not** bring their own caddie.
- Guests will **not be** permitted.
- Players are **only** permitted to use the practice facilities at Somerset Hills Country Club on the day of their scheduled practice round **and** no more than one hour before their scheduled practice round.
- During the practice round, players should play from appropriate tee markers. Please be aware of your pace of play.
- Please note that there will be internal out of bounds on Holes 6 and 9 during the Championship. Additional information can be found on the Championship Golf Genius page under 'Tournament Information'.

- Tuesday, July 30<sup>th</sup> after 3:00 p.m.
- Wednesday, July 31<sup>st</sup> after 3:00 p.m.

### DRESS

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players must wear collared shirts. Wearing jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited. The Committee in charge decides whether this requirement has been met and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.
