- Starting Times:** East Course: Tee times from 7:30 a.m. to 9:40 a.m. / 12:30 p.m. to 2:10 p.m.  
West Course: Shotgun starts at 8:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.
- Format:** There are four separate competitions for **each** course:
1. Low Professional
  2. Professional on Low Net Team
  3. 18-hole Best Ball of Foursome, Low Gross
  4. 18-hole Best Ball of Foursome, Low Net (80% of Course Handicap for Amateur Players)
- The Professional/Host is responsible for maintaining the scorecard of the team. At the completion of the round, the scorecard shall be signed by the Professional/Host and attested by one of the team members. Penalties for violations shall be consistent with other scoring rules (see Rule 6-6).
- Hole in One Contest:** Our partners at Lexus will be sponsoring Hole-in-One Contests at Hole #3 on the East Course and Hole #10 on the West Course.

Lunch will be available in the Main Dining Room from 11:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.  
Cocktail Reception will take place after 5:00 p.m. on the Terrace.  
Additional snacks and sports drinks will be available on course.
- Practice Facilities:** The Putting Greens and Driving Range (**irons only**) will be open at 6:30 a.m. There is limited space available at the Driving Range. The short game practice area will be **closed** in order to preserve it for the Met Open Championship the following day.
- Registration:** All participants are required to report to the Registration Tent to check in, confirm payment and handicap information, and collect tee gift.
- Locker Room:** The Locker Room will be available at 6:00 a.m. Players will have access to a locker.
- Parking:** Players may enter the property through either the Fenimore Road or Old White Plains Road entrances and self-park. Club staff will shuttle players from the parking lot to the Registration Tent. Due to limited parking we **strongly suggest** carpooling with some or all of your teammates.

**Caddies:** This is a WALKING EVENT only. All players will be assigned club caddies. The base fee for the caddies is being paid courtesy of the MGA, and each player is asked to provide a \$30 gratuity to your caddie. If you need to request a cart due to a medical reason, please contact the MGA Championship Department by **Monday, August 17<sup>th</sup>**. **Participants playing in the Met Open who are bringing their own caddie for the Pro-Am must inform Winged Foot Caddie Master Dave Zona at [dzona@wfgc.org](mailto:dzona@wfgc.org) in advance.**

**Pace of Play:** All players should be conscious of their pace of play and maintain contact with the group ahead of them. If your ball cannot help your team on a given hole you are encouraged to pick up.

**Dress Code:** Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players and caddies must wear collared shirts. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited.

**Reception:** Players are encouraged to join us for a Cocktail Reception and Awards Reception following the end of play. Awards will be distributed during the cocktail reception following the end of play. The MGA will ship awards to those participants who are not present to collect their award at the reception.

**Course Setup:** There will be separate tees for Professionals, Amateurs, and Females. Female amateurs will compete at the standard Ladies Tees yardage on each course. Female professionals will compete from the Amateur Tees.
